## WHERE THERE IS LOVE

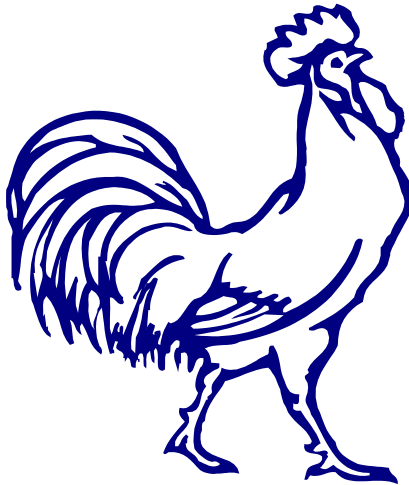
